Waltenhofen · The staff of the casting plant Waltenhofen let the chicken or the meatloaf taste: After months of trepidation about the future of its operation Dr. Ruja Ignatova and her father Plamen Ignatov hold the key for the plant in hands. And that will be celebrated with a hearty snack.

Not only is the 30-year-old lawyer and clerk exudes optimism and commitment. Also in the workforce, there is optimism as council Georg Raith reaffirmed. After a long dry spell in the knowledge that things could not go on, be the most hopeful and have the feeling: ". Now everything fits" For the cast was the end of December bankruptcy filed, which was managed by the Ulmer firm Schneider Geiwitz.
